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# REGISTRATION OF ENGINEERS ACT 1967

## REGISTRATION OF ENGINEERS REGULATIONS 1990\*

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 26 of the Registration of Engineers Act 1967, the Board of Engineers, with the approval of the Minister, makes the following regulations: *Act 138.*

### PART I

#### PRELIMINARY

1. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the **Registration of Engineers Regulations 1990**.

(2) These Regulations shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st July 1987.

(3) All acts done after the 1st July 1987 and before the publication of these Regulations shall be deemed to have been lawfully done under these Regulations as if these Regulations were in force when the same were done.

2. In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires—

Interpretation.

“Board” means the Board of Engineers established by section 3 (1) of the Act;

“foreign engineer” means an engineer who is not a citizen or permanent resident of Malaysia;

“President” means the President of the Board appointed under section 3 (2) of the Act;

“Professional Engineer in private practice” means a registered Professional Engineer (other than a salaried employee) who is engaged in advising on engineering matters or in designing and supervising the construction of engineering works whether he is so engaged alone or in partnership;

“Registrar” means the Registrar of Engineers appointed under section 6 (1) of the Act;

“Secretary” means the Secretary appointed by the Board under regulation 9.

### PART II

#### ADMINISTRATION

3. (1) The Secretary shall convene a meeting of the Board whenever requested to do so by the President or in writing by not less than five members of the Board.

(2) The Secretary shall consult the President on any business other than of a routine nature requiring attention before each meeting of the Board.

4. (1) Not less than fourteen day's notice in writing shall be given specifying the place, date and time of a meeting and the business to be conducted in such meeting.

(2) The accidental omission to give notice of a meeting under this regulation to one or more members of the Board or the non-receipt thereof shall not in any manner affect the validity of or prejudice anything done or agreed to at such meeting.

5. A resolution shall be proposed and seconded before being put to the vote. Voting shall be by show of hands or by secret ballot as may be decided by the President or the member presiding. A declaration by the President or the member presiding that a resolution has been carried by a particular majority shall be conclusive, and an entry to that effect in the minutes of the meeting shall be conclusive evidence thereof without proof of the number or proportion of votes recorded in favour of or against such resolution.

6. Votes shall only be given by members present and voting.

7. Minutes of every meeting shall be kept by the Secretary and such minutes if purporting to be signed by the President or the member presiding of the next succeeding meeting shall be conclusive evidence of the facts stated therein.

8. (1) The Board may from time to time by resolution appoint committees from amongst its members or persons whom the Board considers suitable; and the Board may by resolution at any time dissolve any committee so appointed.

(2) A committee appointed under sub-regulation (1) may invite any person to attend its meeting and to take part in its deliberation but such person shall have no vote.

(3) The Registrar and the Secretary shall be *ex-officio* members of all committees.

9. (1) The Board may appoint a person to act as Secretary to the Board.

(2) The Secretary shall keep the minutes of all meetings of the Board and its committees and shall send notices of meetings and perform such other functions as may be determined by the Board.

(3) The Secretary shall receive and be responsible for all monies payable to the Board and shall present—

- (a) at each meeting of the Board a statement of account showing receipts and expenditure as on the last day of the month preceding the month of the meeting; and
- (b) not later than 30th June in each year the audited accounts for the preceding financial year.

10. All payments received shall be deposited to the credit of the account of the Board with a bank or banks approved by the Board, provided that the Secretary may keep as petty cash a sum not exceeding fifty ringgit. Bank account.

11. All cheques on the bank account of the Board shall, unless and until otherwise from time to time resolved by the Board, be signed by the President or in his absence by a member appointed for that purpose by the Board and two other members of the Board. Cheque.

12. (1) The Board shall cause to be kept and maintained proper accounts and records relating to— Accounts.

- (a) the assets and liabilities of the Board;
- (b) the sums of money received and expended by or under the authority of the Board.

(2) The books of accounts and records shall be kept in the custody of the Secretary or at such place as the Board may determine.

13. (1) The President, the Registrar and the Secretary may be paid from the funds of the Board such remuneration as the Board may determine from time to time. Expenses of the Board.

(2) There may be paid to members of the Board and members of committees such allowances for attending meetings of the Board or the committee thereof, such reasonable travelling expenses and subsistence allowances for being away from their place of residence for performing the duties of the Board.

14. The accounts of the Board shall at least once every year be audited. Audit.

15. The financial year of the Board shall end on 31st December. Financial year.

### PART III

#### REGISTRATION OF GRADUATE ENGINEERS AND PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS

16. (1) Every person desirous of being registered as a Graduate Engineer under the Act shall make an application to the Board in Form A in the Schedule. Forms of application.

(2) Every person desirous of being registered as a Professional Engineer under the Act shall make an application to the Board in Form B1 in the Schedule.

(3) Every foreign engineer desirous of being temporarily registered as a Professional Engineer under the Act shall make an application to the Board in Form B2 in the Schedule.

17. Every application for registration shall be decided upon by the Board within 4 months from the date of receipt of such application.

18. (1) No registration fee is chargeable in respect of registration of a Graduate Engineer under the Act. ✓

(2) Any person whose application for registration as a Professional Engineer made under sub-regulation (2) of regulation 16 has been approved shall, within two months of the date of notification of such approval, pay to the Board a registration fee of one hundred and fifty ringgit.

(3) Any foreign engineer whose application for temporary registration as a Professional Engineer made under sub-regulation (3) of regulation 16 has been approved shall, within two months of the date of notification of such approval, pay to the Board a registration fee of two hundred ringgit.

(4) Failure to pay the registration fee within the period stipulated under sub-regulation (2) or (3), as the case may be, shall be treated as if the application has been withdrawn by such person, and no subsequent application from him shall be considered before the expiry of one year from the date on which his previous application was approved:

Provided that the Board may consider an application before the expiry of the aforementioned period if it is satisfied that failure to pay the registration fee in respect of the previous approval was for sufficient cause or reason.

19. (1) An Engineer registered under the Act shall be issued with a certificate duly signed by the President and the Registrar and sealed with the common seal of the Board.

(2) A certificate of registration issued to a Graduate Engineer shall be in Form C in the Schedule. ✓

(3) A certificate of registration issued to a Professional Engineer shall be in Form D1 in the Schedule.

(4) A certificate of temporary registration issued to a foreign engineer as a Professional Engineer under the Act shall be in Form D2 in the Schedule.

20. (1) Every Professional Engineer desirous of renewing his registration under section 13 (2) of the Act shall submit to the Board an application for renewal in Form H in the Schedule on or before 31st January of the year following the year of the expiration of his registration and accompanied

with the renewal fee in the form of money order, bank draft or cheque made in favour of the Board.

(2) The renewal fee in respect of a foreign engineer shall be two hundred ringgit, and in respect of any other Engineer shall be one hundred ringgit.

21. Any person whose name has been removed from the Register pursuant to section 16 (b) of the Act for failure to renew his registration shall, when notifying the Registrar of his desire to be reinstated pursuant to section 17 (2) of the Act, pay a reinstatement fee of one hundred and fifty ringgit.

Fee for  
reinstatement.

22. (1) The practical experience that a registered Graduate Engineer is required to obtain under section 10 (1) (b) of the Act in order to be entitled to apply for registration as a Professional Engineer shall be carried out in a manner satisfactory to the Board for a period of three years—

Practical  
experience.

- (a) in the planning, design, execution or management of such works as comprised within the profession of engineering;
- (b) in engineering research; or
- (c) in the teaching in a course leading to a qualification approved by the Board,

and at least one year of such practical experience shall be obtained in Malaysia under the supervision of a registered Professional Engineer of the same discipline or an approved allied discipline and shall be in fields of engineering practice other than in research or teaching.

(2) Notwithstanding sub-regulation (1), if the Board is satisfied for sufficient cause or reason, the Board may in any particular case exempt either wholly or partially the requirement as to the practical experience required to be obtained in Malaysia or the requirement as to the supervision by a registered Professional Engineer in Malaysia:

Provided that the total practical experience to be obtained shall not be less than three years.

(3) A registered Graduate Engineer applying for registration as a Professional Engineer under section 10 (2) of the Act shall submit with his application proof in writing of his practical experience. Such submission shall include details of duration and the description of the practical experience and a statement by the said supervisory Professional Engineer under sub-regulation (1) in the case of experience obtained in Malaysia or by an engineer acceptable to the Board in the case of experience obtained outside Malaysia, that the registered Graduate Engineer has satisfactorily completed his practical experience.

PART IV

CODE OF PROFESSIONAL CONDUCT

23. Every Registered Engineer shall at all times uphold the dignity, high standing and reputation of his profession.

24. A Registered Engineer in his responsibility to his employer, client or the profession shall have full regard to the public interest.

25. (1) A Registered Engineer shall discharge his duties to his employer or client as the case may be with complete fidelity.

(2) Except with the permission of his employer, a Registered Engineer shall not accept any remuneration for services rendered other than from his employer.

26. A Registered Engineer shall not maliciously injure or attempt to maliciously injure whether directly or indirectly, the professional reputation, prospects or business of another Registered Engineer.

27. A Registered Engineer shall not—

- (a) canvass or solicit professional employment;
- (b) offer to make by way of commission or any other payment for the introduction of his professional employment; or
- (c) except as permitted by the Board, advertise in any manner or form in connection with his profession.

28. A Professional Engineer in private practice shall not practise engineering with any person whose registration has been cancelled.

29. A Professional Engineer in private practice shall not be a medium of payment made on his client's behalf unless he is so requested by his client nor shall he, in connection with work on which he is employed, place contracts or orders except with the authority of and on behalf of his client.

30. A Professional Engineer in private practice shall not without the approval of the Board enter into professional partnership with any person other than a Professional Engineer in private practice, a Registered Architect, a Registered Quantity Surveyor or a Licensed Land Surveyor.

31. A Professional Engineer in private practice shall not directly or indirectly—

- (a) supplant or attempt to supplant another Professional Engineer in private practice;



- (b) intervene or attempt to intervene in or in connection with engineering work of any kind which to his knowledge has already been entrusted to another Professional Engineer in private practice; or
- (c) take over any work of that other Professional Engineer in private practice acting for the same client unless he has—
  - (i) obtained the consent of that other Engineer; or
  - (ii) been formally notified by the client that the services of that other Engineer have been terminated in accordance with the provisions of any contract entered into between that other Engineer and the client.

Restrictions on being a director, member or shareholder of contracting and manufacturing company, etc.

32. (1) Except with the prior approval of the Board, a Professional Engineer in private practice shall not be a director or executive of or substantial shareholder in or agent for any contracting or manufacturing company or firm or business related to building or engineering.

(2) If such approval is given, such Professional Engineer shall not undertake any contract work wherein he is engaged as a consulting engineer in such project unless it is in respect of a "design and build" project.

Disclosure of interest.

33. Every Registered Engineer while acting in his professional capacity shall disclose in writing to his client of the fact if he is a director or member of or substantial shareholder in or agent for any contracting or manufacturing company or firm or business or has any financial interest in any such company or firm or business, with which he deals on behalf of his client.

## PART V

### REGISTRATION OF BODIES CORPORATE PRACTISING AS CONSULTING ENGINEERS

Form of application for body corporate to practise as consulting engineers and registration fee for body corporate.

34. (1) Every body corporate desirous of practising as consulting engineers under section 7A of the Act shall submit an application to the Board in Form E in the Schedule.

(2) Every such application shall be accompanied by a fee of twenty-five ringgit in the form of money order, bank draft or cheque made in favour of the Board.

Permit for body corporate to practise as consulting engineers.

35. When the application made under regulation 34 is approved by the Board, the Board shall issue a permit to the applicant in Form F in the Schedule.

Renewal of permit.

36. (1) Every body corporate desirous of renewing the permit issued pursuant to regulation 35 shall submit to the Board an application for

renewal in Form H in the Schedule on or before 31st-January of the year following the year of the expiration of the permit and accompanied by the renewal fee of twenty-five ringgit in the form of money order, bank draft or cheque made in favour of the Board.

(2) On receipt of such application for renewal, the Board shall issue to the applicant a permit in Form F in the Schedule.

## PART VI

### PROFESSIONAL ASSESSMENT EXAMINATION

37. Every registered Graduate Engineer having the practical experience as mentioned in regulation 22 desirous of sitting for the Professional Assessment Examination for the purpose of applying to be registered as a Professional Engineer shall submit to the Board his application in Form G in the Schedule and accompanied by a fee of two hundred ringgit in the form of money order, bank draft or cheque made in favour of the Board.

Form of application to sit for Professional Assessment Examination.

38. The Professional Assessment Examination that a registered Graduate Engineer has to pass under section 10 (2) (i) (c) of the Act in order to be entitled to be registered as a Professional Engineer shall consist of—

Professional Assessment Examination.

- (a) a professional interview conducted by not less than two examiners appointed by the Board from time to time;
- (b) a written paper on a technical subject related to the practical experience which he has obtained; and
- (c) a written paper on his understanding of the Code of Professional Conduct.

## PART VII

### REVOCATION

39. The Registration of Engineers Regulations 1972 are revoked with effect from the commencement of these Regulations.
